The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, October 6, 2009 with Honorable Mayor Barbara C. "Sami" Barile presiding and the following named Councilmembers present: Gene Brooks, Bob Garrett, Claude Jinks, Frank McGuffin, William Rooney and Kay Senter.

Councilmember McGuffin made a motion to approve the September 15, 2009 minutes as circulated; Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Mayor Barile read and presented a proclamation to representatives of the local arts community recognizing October as National Arts and Humanities Month.

Councilmember Rooney made a motion to award the bid for precast concrete sanitary products to Sherman Dixie at a per unit cost. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to hire an Interim City Administrator; Councilmember Jinks seconded the motion. Upon roll call, Councilmembers Brooks, Garrett, Jinks and Senter voted "aye"; Councilmembers McGuffin, Rooney and Mayor Barile voted "no".

Councilmember Garrett made a motion to hire Mr. Lynn Wampler as Interim City Administrator; Councilmember Jinks seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

City Council convened as the Beer Board.

Councilmember Rooney made a motion to grant an Off-Premise Beer Permit for Little Dandy Market, 1635 South Cumberland. Councilmember McGuffin seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Mayor Barile adjourned the October 6, 2009 City Council meeting.
