The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, November 18, 2008 with Honorable Mayor Barbara C. "Sam" Barile presiding and the following named Councilmembers present: Claude Jinks, Frank McGuffin, William Rooney, Kay Senter and Rick Trent; Absent: Councilmember Mel Tucker.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to approve the November 4, 2008 minutes as circulated; Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to adopt the following Resolution No. 32-08; Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

**Resolution No. 32-08
A Resolution to Support the FY2009
Transportation Enhancement Program Grant
Application for the Evelyn B. Johnson Garden and
Education Trail.**

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee Department of Transportation has a competitive grant opportunity for Transportation Enhancement Projects for communities within the State of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, the City of Morristown has a greenway master plan for the community offering recreation opportunities to its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee Department of Transportation allows greenway trails as part of the enhancement grant program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Morristown would like to continue the development of the Greenway with a trail from Alpha Elementary School along Old Andrew Johnson Highway (Honorary Evelyn Bryan Johnson Drive) to the Morristown Airport and would submit another Tennessee Enhancement Grant application to complete the trail from Alpha Elementary School to the Morristown Airport as an educational trail with public art and educational signage; and

WHEREAS, the City of Morristown would request the State of Tennessee to award the FY2009 Tennessee Enhancement Grant Application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that The City of Morristown hereby requests the awarding of the FY2009 Tennessee Enhancement Program Grant Application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and approval.

**Ordinance No. 3351
Entitled an Ordinance to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Morristown, Tennessee, Appendix B. {Rezoning of property located at 408 Mars Street and 610 & 616 West Third North Street from Medium Density Residential (R-2) to Office, Medical & Professional (OMP).}**

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to adopt the following captioned Ordinance No. 3352 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for December 2, 2008. Councilmember Trent seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3352
Entitled an Ordinance to rename a certain public street within the corporate boundaries of the City of Morristown, Tennessee. (Street renaming – "Greene Drive" to "Lochmere Greene Drive".)**

Councilmember McGuffin made a motion to adopt the following captioned Ordinance No. 3344 on second and final reading. Councilmember Jinks seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3344
Entitled an Ordinance to amend the Municipal Code, Title 12, by adopting certain amendments thereto relative to Building, Housing, Gas, Plumbing and Fire Prevention Codes.**

Councilmember Senter made a motion to authorize the purchase of the Robert & Phyllis Brockwell property located on Fourth South & Mill Streets at the price of \$55,000. Councilmember Trent seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Councilmember Rooney made a motion to accept the Hamblen County Election Commission's certification of the November 4, 2008 Election results on the Liquor Referendum. {4529 for / 4099 against}

Councilmember Rooney made a motion to accept Councilmember Mel Tucker's resignation as City Councilmember effective November 30, 2008. Councilmember Jinks seconded the motion and upon roll call all voted "aye".

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to donate \$10,000 to the HC*EXCELL Imagination Library Program. Councilmember McGuffin seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Councilmember Jinks made a motion that December 26th be given to City employees as an additional Christmas holiday. Councilmember Trent seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

CITY COUNCIL CONVENED AS THE BEER BOARD.

Councilmember Rooney made a motion to grant an On-Premise Beer Permit to East Tennessee Wings & Grill, 2550 E. Morris Blvd. (College Square Mall). Councilmember McGuffin seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".
