

**STATE OF TENNESSEE

CORPORATION OF MORRISTOWN
NOVEMBER 20, 2007**

The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, November 20, 2007 with Honorable Mayor Barbara C. "Sami" Barile presiding and the following named Councilmembers present: Frank McGuffin, William Rooney, Kay Senter, Rick Trent and Mel Tucker; absent: Councilmember Claude Jinks.

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the November 6, 2007 minutes as circulated; Councilmember McGuffin seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

Mayor Barile presented a Proclamation to Dennis Alvis in recognition of his retirement from the Parks & Recreation Department.

Councilmember Senter made a motion to open the agenda and add Ordinance No. 3307 – R-O-W closing on West 13th North to the agenda; Councilmember McGuffin seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

Councilmember Tucker made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3307 on second and final reading with the addition of an addendum to the Rock of Ages Church deed relative to a transportation easement for public access to the cemetery. Councilmember Trent seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

The Public Hearing on the Needs Assessment for the 2008 Community Development Block Grant and the selection of an architectural firm to design the new Community Center were postponed until the December 4, 2007 Council meeting.

The Resolutions to local and state officials regarding illegal immigrants were deferred – joint City/County Resolutions will be prepared.

Councilmember McGuffin made a motion to adopt the following captioned Ordinance No. 3308 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for December 4, 2007. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Entitled an Ordinance to close and vacate certain right-of-ways within the City of Morristown. {Closing an undeveloped portion of Lennie Street.}

Councilmember Senter made a motion to adopt the following captioned Ordinance No. 3313 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for December 4, 2007. Councilmember McGuffin seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3313

Entitled an Ordinance to close and vacate certain right-of-ways within the City of Morristown. {Closing an undeveloped portion of Sunrise Avenue.}

Councilmember Senter made a motion to adopt the following captioned Ordinance No. 3314 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for December 4, 2007. Councilmember McGuffin seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3314

Entitled an Ordinance to close and vacate certain right-of-ways within the City of Morristown. {Closing an undeveloped alley off South Jackson Street.}

Councilmember Tucker made a motion to award the Professional Services Agreement for the development and implementation of phase Ia Storm Water Utility and User Fee to AMEC in the amount of \$171,074. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, Councilmembers Rooney, Senter, Tucker and Mayor Barile voted "aye"; Councilmembers McGuffin and Trent voted "no".

Councilmember Rooney made a motion to re-appoint Jackie Jinks to the Morristown-Hamblen Child Care Centers Board for a two-year term to expire on November 20, 2009. Councilmember Trent seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

The report from Attorney Jessee on his research on illegal aliens was postponed.

Councilmember Tucker made a motion to authorize Sheriff Jarnigan to make application for ten officers to attend the 287 G Program ICE certification training; further action on funding will be considered after acceptance. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to authorize an emergency expense to repair damages caused by a train derailment on the MAID railroad spur in the amount of \$43,865.86 (expense to be reimbursed by Norfolk Southern); Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

City Council Convened as the Beer Board.

Councilmember Tucker made a motion to grant an Off-Premise Beer Permit to Mayur J. Shah, West Side Market, 303 Jarnigan Avenue. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call; Councilmembers McGuffin, Rooney, Senter, Tucker and Mayor Barile voted "aye"; Councilmember Trent voted "no".

Mayor Barile adjourned the November 20, 2007 City Council meeting.
