DECEMBER 19, 2006**

The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, December 19, 2006 with Honorable Mayor Gary R. Johnson presiding and the following named Councilmembers present: Claude Jinks, Frank McGuffin, William Rooney, Kay Senter, Rick Trent and Mel Tucker.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to approve the December 5, 2006 minutes as circulated; Councilmember Tucker seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Action on Ordinance No. 3269 - FY 2006 Budget Amendment was postponed until December 29, 2006.

A public hearing was held on the Community Development Block Grant FY2007 Action Plan. Melissa Peagler, City Planner, gave a brief overview. Mayor Johnson opened the public hearing. 1. Nigel Reid asked what the grant was for; what part of town; and if he could get a copy? There being no further comments, Mayor Johnson closed the public hearing.

Chief Overholt gave an overview of his recommendations on solicitations at traffic signals. Mayor Johnson requested that the Chief make a list of the proposed changes and have the City Attorney prepare a document and bring it back to Council for debate.

Without objection from Council an item regarding proposals for Group Life and Long-Term Disability Insurance was added to the agenda.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to approve the proposals for Long Term Disability to Standard Insurance Co. in the amount of \$32,531; and the Life, ADD and Dependand Life to Mutual of Omaha in the amount of \$46,777. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Mayor Johnson adjourned the December 19, 2006 meeting.
