

**STATE OF TENNESSEE

CORPORATION OF MORRISTOWN
FEBRUARY 19, 2008**

The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 19, 2008 with Honorable Mayor Barbara C. "Sami" Barile presiding and the following named Councilmembers present: Claude Jinks, Frank McGuffin, William Rooney, Kay Senter, Rick Trent and Mel Tucker.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to approve the February 5, 2008 minutes as circulated; Councilmember McGuffin seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to award the proposal for the East End Pumping System Review to Lamar Dunn & Associates in the amount of \$29,000. Councilmember Jinks seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Action on the rezoning of property located at Cherokee Park Road/Davy Crockett Parkway was deferred until a traffic study is completed.

Councilmember Tucker made a motion to adopt the following captioned Ordinance No. 3319 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for March 4, 2008. Councilmember Jinks seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3319
Entitled an Ordinance to amend Title 14 of the
Morristown Municipal Code by amending Chapter 1 –
Municipal Planning Commission, Section 14-102, by
deleting said section in its entirety and substituting a
new Section 14-102.**

Councilmember Tucker made a motion to adopt the following captioned Ordinance No. 3318 on second and final reading; Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3318
Entitled an Ordinance to amend the Fiscal Year
2007 Budget by providing for appropriations from
revenue and expenditure accounts on an
individual fund and line item basis.**

Councilmember Tucker made a motion to re-submit Resolution No. 19-07, which was unanimously adopted February 20, 2007 regarding amending the Civil Service Act, to Representative Litz with the omission of Section 9 – "When a position in the Classified Service becomes vacant, whether entry level or promotional, the governing body of the City of Morristown shall make requisition upon the Board for the names of five (5) persons highest on the eligible list willing to accept employment. These five (5) persons shall be considered to be qualified for the position under consideration." Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve change order #2 for installation of a sewer casing pipe for the Industrial Access Road (Veterans Parkway) serving Colgate Manufacturing in the amount of \$20,019.60. Councilmember Trent seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Councilmember Tucker made a motion to approve the Police Department Organizational Design as presented by Chief Overholt; Councilmember Jinks seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted “aye”.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to accept Chief Overholt’s recommendation and approve the following promotions within the Police Department; Councilmember Tucker seconded and upon roll call, all voted “aye”:

Councilmember Tucker made a motion to approve an Off-Premise Beer Permit for Dipak Patel, Shree Hari Prasab, Inc., dba, BP Buffalo Trail, 1736 Buffalo Trail. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted “aye”.
