The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, May 19, 2009 with Honorable Mayor Barbara C. "Sami" Barile presiding and the following named Councilmembers present: Gene Brooks, Bob Garrett, Claude Jinks, Frank McGuffin, William Rooney and Kay Senter.

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the April 21, 2009 minutes as circulated; Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

Councilmember McGuffin made a motion to approve the May 11, 2009 (Sine Die) minutes as circulated; Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

Mayor Barile read and presented a proclamation recognizing Boy Scout Explorer Post #784 on their success in the 2009 Explorer Weekend.

Councilmember McGuffin made a motion to adopt the following captioned Ordinance No. 3361 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for June 2, 2009. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Masengill Market Property located on W. Andrew Johnson
Hwy. and Old Poplar Ridge Road, HCTM 47, Group F, Parcels
71.00, 71.02 & 71.03, from Single Family Residential (R-1) to
Intermediate Business (IB).}**

Ordinance No. 3362

Entitled and Ordinance to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Morristown, Tennessee, Appendix B.

{Rezoning of property located at HCTM 34P, Group A, Parcels 5.00, 6.00, 28.00, 29.00 and 30.00/ Fred Miller Park area from Medium Density Residential (R-2) to Central Business District (CBD).}

Councilmember McGuffin made a motion to adopt the following captioned Ordinance No. 3363 on first reading; Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3363

Entitled an Ordinance to close and vacate certain rights-of-way within the City of Morristown. {Right-of-Way Closure: South Mill Street/Fred Miller Park.}

Mayor Barile appointed Councilmember Bob Garret to the Tree Board for tenure of office, to replace former Councilmember Rick Trent. Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the appointment; Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, Councilmember Garrett "abstained"; all others voted "aye".
