

**STATE OF TENNESSEE

CORPORATION OF MORRISTOWN
JUNE 20, 2006**

The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 20, 2006 with Honorable Mayor Gary R. Johnson presiding and the following named Councilmembers present: Claude Jinks, Frank McGuffin, William Rooney, Rick Trent and Mel Tucker; absent: Councilmember Kay Senter.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to approve the June 6, 2006 minutes as circulated; Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

A public hearing was held on the following captioned Ordinance No. 3254. Councilmember Trent made a motion to postpone said Ordinance until the next meeting; Councilmember McGuffin seconded the motion. Upon roll call, Councilmembers Jinks, Rooney, Tucker and Mayor Johnson voted "no"; Councilmembers McGuffin and Trent voted "aye". Councilmember Rooney made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 3254 on second and final reading; Councilmember Tucker seconded the motion and upon roll call, Councilmembers Jinks, McGuffin, Rooney, Tucker and Mayor Johnson voted "aye"; Councilmember Trent voted "no".

**Ordinance No. 3254
Entitled an Ordinance to amend Title 18, Chapter 4
(Water Pollution Control Ordinance No. 3140) of the
Municipal Code of the City of Morristown, Tennessee.
(Sewer fees)**

A public hearing was held on the following captioned Ordinance No. 3255. Councilmember Jinks made a motion to adopt said Ordinance on first reading; Councilmember Tucker seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3255
Entitled an Ordinance to appropriate various tax revenues and
general city revenues for and by the City of Morristown to the
city budget divisions for the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 (FY 2007)
and the levy of a tax on all taxable property within the
corporate limits of the City of Morristown, Tennessee, for
municipal purposes authorized by law to be taxed, same
being levied as of the first (1st) day of January 2006, for the
Fiscal Year 2007, at the certified tax rate of \$0.97 on each \$100
worth of taxable property.**

Councilmember Tucker made a motion to award the Engineering Services Contract for design of the sanitary sewer extension to the Valley Home Road area to Hodge Associates in the amount of \$71,350. Councilmember McGuffin seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Councilmember McGuffin made a motion to table the following Ordinance No. 3256 until the July 18, 2006 City Council meeting; Councilmember Jinks seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3256
Entitled an Ordinance to annex certain territory and to incorporate same within the corporate boundaries of the City of Morristown, Tennessee. {Annexation and Zoning Classification of the property located along Howell Road, Merchants Greene Boulevard, South Bellwood Road, Jay Street, Ray Street, Piper Street, Dearing Road, Alpha Valley Home Road, Air Park Boulevard and Maple Valley Road.}

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to adopt the following captioned Ordinance No. 3257 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for July 18, 2006.

Ordinance No. 3257
Entitled an Ordinance to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Morristown, Appendix B. {Rezoning of property located at the corner of West Morris Boulevard and Bowman Drive from Heavy Industrial (HI) to Intermediate Business (IB).}

Councilmember Tucker made a motion to adopt the following captioned Ordinance No. 3253 on second and final reading. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, Councilmembers Jinks, McGuffin, Rooney, Tucker and Mayor Johnson voted "aye"; Councilmember Trent voted "no".

Ordinance No. 3253
Entitled an Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 2963 establishing a maximum amount for purchases without public advertisement and competitive bidding.

Councilmember McGuffin made a motion to re-appoint James Craine, R. Jack Fishman, Breck Habegger and Keith Powers to the Industrial Development Board for six year terms to expire June 30, 2012; Councilmember Jinks seconded. Councilmember Rooney made a motion that nominations cease and they be elected by acclamation; all voted aye. A recommendation for the seat held by William Swann will be obtained from the Board since Dick Jessee, City Attorney, feels that Mr. Swann is ineligible to serve on the Board according to State statutes.

CITY COUNCIL CONVENED AS THE BEER BOARD.

Councilmember Rooney made a motion to grant an On-Premise Beer Permit to Zhen Yong Guo, Top's China buffet, 1336 West Andrew Johnson Highway. Councilmember Tucker seconded the motion and upon roll call all voted "aye".

Councilmember Rooney made a motion to grant an On-Premise Beer Permit to Marci Ann Garner and Lori Lee Zednick, GZ's Grill, Inc., 4397 East Morris Blvd. Councilmember Tucker seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Mayor Johnson adjourned the June 20, 2006 meeting.
