JUNE 23, 2009**

The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in a special called session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, June 23, 2009 with Honorable Mayor Barbara C. "Sami" Barile presiding and the following named Councilmembers present: Gene Brooks, Bob Garrett, Claude Jinks, Frank McGuffin, William Rooney and Kay Senter.

A public hearing was held on the following captioned Ordinance No. 3368 Councilmember Rooney made a motion to adopt said Ordinance on first reading. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call, Councilmembers McGuffin, Rooney, Senter and Mayor Barile voted "aye"; Councilmembers Brooks, Garrett and Jinks voted "no".

**Ordinance No. 3368  
Entitled an Ordinance to appropriate various sewer revenues collected for and by the City of Morristown to the City's Sewer Budget Divisions for the Fiscal Year 2009-2010 (FY 2010).**

Councilmember McGuffin made a motion to adopt the following captioned Ordinance No. 3367 (setting the sewer rates with an 8% increase per year for the next three years) on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for June 24, 2009 at 12:30 p.m. Councilmember Jinks seconded the motion and upon roll call, Councilmembers Jinks, McGuffin, Rooney, Senter and Mayor Barile voted "aye"; Councilmembers Brooks and Garrett voted "no". *{Councilmember Jinks requested that the rates be reviewed quarterly. Councilmember Senter acknowledged that Council is aware that the adjustment of the rates by only 8% the first year will cause a budget deficit.}*

**Ordinance No. 3367  
Entitled an Ordinance to amend Title 18, Chapter 4 (Water Pollution Control Ordinance No. 3140) of the City of Morristown, Tennessee. {Fees & Charges}**

Councilmember Rooney made a motion to adopt the following captioned Ordinance No. 3365 on second and final reading. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3365  
Entitled an Ordinance to appropriate various Tax Revenues and**

**General City Revenues for and by the City of Morristown to the City Budget Divisions for the Fiscal Year 2009-2010 (FY 2010) and the levy of a tax on all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Morristown, Tennessee, for Municipal purposes authorized by law to be taxed, same being levied as of the first (1<sup>st</sup>) day of January 2009, for the Fiscal Year 2010, at the Certified Tax Rate of \$1.22 on each \$100 worth of taxable property.**

Mayor Barile adjourned the June 23, 2009 City Council meeting.
