The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in "called" session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 12:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 29, 2006 with Honorable Mayor Gary R. Johnson presiding and the following named Councilmembers present: Claude Jinks, Frank McGuffin, William Rooney, Kay Senter, Rick Trent and Mel Tucker.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to adopt the following captioned Ordinance No. 3255 on second and final reading. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3255

Entitled an Ordinance to appropriate various tax revenues and general city revenues for and by the City of Morristown to the city budget divisions for the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 (FY 2007) and the levy of a tax on all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Morristown, Tennessee, for municipal purposes authorized by law to be taxed, same being levied as of the first (1st) day of January 2006, for the Fiscal Year 2007, at the certified tax rate of \$0.97 on each \$100 worth of taxable property.

Mayor Johnson adjourned the June 29, 2006 meeting.
