JULY 7, 2009**

The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 7, 2009 with Honorable Mayor Barbara C. "Sami" Barile presiding and the following named Councilmembers present: Bob Garrett, Claude Jinks, Frank McGuffin, William Rooney and Kay Senter; absent: Councilmember Gene Brooks.

Councilmember Rooney made a motion to approve the June 16, 2009 minutes as circulated; Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to approve the June 23, 2009 called meeting minutes as circulated; Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the June 24, 2009 called meeting minutes as circulated; Councilmember Jinks seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

Mayor Barile announced that Wednesday, July 8<sup>th</sup> would be designated as "Homeless Prevention Awareness Day" in Morristown.

A public hearing was held on the following captioned Ordinance No. 3366. Councilmember Jinks made a motion to adopt said Ordinance on second and final reading; Councilmember McGuffin seconded the motion and upon roll call, Councilmembers Garrett, Jinks, Rooney, Senter and Mayor Barile voted "aye"; Councilmember Senter "abstained".

Entitled an Ordinance to amend the Municipal Code of the  
City of Morristown, Tennessee, Appendix B. {Rezoning of  
property along Cherokee Park Road/ N. Davy Crockett  
Parkway, 2750 N. Davy Crockett Parkway (HCTM 17, Parcel  
17.01) and a portion of Cherokee Park from Medium Density  
Residential (R-2) to Intermediate Business (IB).}**

Administrator Crumley reported that the Lowland Wastewater Treatment Plant purchase was closed on June 30, 2009 and that Veolia Water took over the operation the same day.

Councilmember McGuffin made a motion to approve Change Order #2 to Wild Building Contractors for renovations to the Airport Building in the amount of \$20,558.77. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to grant an Off-Premise Beer Permit to Kenneth E. McMullen for Weigel Stores, Inc., 2750 North Davy Crockett Parkway. Councilmember McGuffin seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".
