The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, March 4, 2008 with Honorable Mayor Barbara C. "Sami" Barile presiding and the following named Councilmembers present: Claude Jinks, William Rooney, Kay Senter, Rick Trent and Mel Tucker; absent: Councilmember Frank McGuffin.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to approve the February 19, 2008 minutes as circulated; Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to approve the February 29, 2008 minutes as circulated; Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

A public hearing was held on the following captioned Ordinance No. 3319. Councilmember Jinks made a motion to adopt said Ordinance on second and final reading; Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3319  
Entitled an Ordinance to amend Title 14 of the  
Morristown Municipal Code by amending Chapter 1 –  
Municipal Planning Commission, Section 14-102, by  
deleting said section in its entirety and substituting a  
new Section 14-102.**

A public hearing was held on the following captioned Ordinance No. 3320. Councilmember Rooney made a motion to adopt said Ordinance on first reading; Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3320  
Entitled an Ordinance to amend the Morristown  
Municipal Code, Title 18 – Water and Sewers, by  
adding Chapter 5 - Stormwater Utility Service Charges.**

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to award the Engineering/Services Contract for alterations to the airport facility (Mechanic's School) to Fuller Architects in the amount of \$14,400 plus reimbursables not to exceed \$2,500. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to award the Engineering/Services Contract for design of a new airport terminal building to Fuller Architects in the amount of \$82,640 plus reimbursables not to exceed \$2,500. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Mayor Barile re-appointed Rev. Clifton Jackson to the Morristown Regional Planning Commission for a four-year term to expire March 1, 2012.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to declare 25,000 rounds of .40 caliber ammunition as surplus property and authorize the sale thereof to the Greene County Sheriff's Department for \$175 per 1,000 rounds. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Mayor Barile adjourned the March 4, 2008 City Council meeting.
