

P.A.T.H. Guidelines and Complete Rules

1. Points can be earned by:

- Walking, jogging, or running the Greenway.
 - Attending or volunteering work at Parks and Recreation Events and receiving verification of attendance.
 - Participating in Parks and Recreation classes or programs.
 - Participating in or attending a Parks and Recreation organized sports league game.
 - Playing the Kiwanis Disc Golf Course

2. Points are only good during the calendar year obtained. There will be no rollover of point to future years. Participants may only cash in points for one item per year.

3. T-shirt will be awarded to all participants who obtain 100 points, but will not be counted as their one item.

4. Points can be cashed in for park dollars at the rate of \$0.05 per point. Park dollars may only be used for Pavilion rentals and/or Talley Ward room discounts. Park Dollars cannot be redeemed for regular currency or change from a purchase. Park dollars have NO actual cash value.

5. The point system will be as follows:

- One mile = 2 points (includes walking, jogging, or running).
 - Program and event points will be assigned at time of activity.
 - 5 points per game played / practice in a Parks and Recreation organized league and/or 1 point per game / practice as a spectator.
 - 1/2 point per hole at the Kiwanis Disc Golf Course
 - 2 points for volunteering work at Parks and Recreation events
 - 1 point for use of the Splash Pad at Fred Miller Park

6. Prize List:

- 100 points = t-shirt
 - 200 points = pedometer
 - 300 points = portable CD player
 - 400 points = Gear Bag
 - 500 points = MP3 Player
 - 600 points = Adjustable Aerobic Vest
 - 700 points = pullover with P.A.T.H. logo
 - 800 points = duffle bag with P.A.T.H. logo
 - 900 points = Exercise Bike
 - 1000 points = \$75 mall gift card
 - 1250 points = \$100 FootLocker Gift Card
 - 1500 points = Family Dome Tent
 - 1750 points = Golf Set
 - 2000 points = Home Gym

7. Points can be turned in at the Parks and Recreation Department during normal hours of operation. Prizes will be awarded no longer than two weeks after turning in points.

8. Participants agree to self monitor the program. Fraudulent submission of point redemption to receive prizes could result in criminal prosecution under the statutes of State of Tennessee.

9. P.A.T.H. forms can be picked up at the Parks and Recreation Department. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to modify the P.A.T.H.'s program at any given time.
