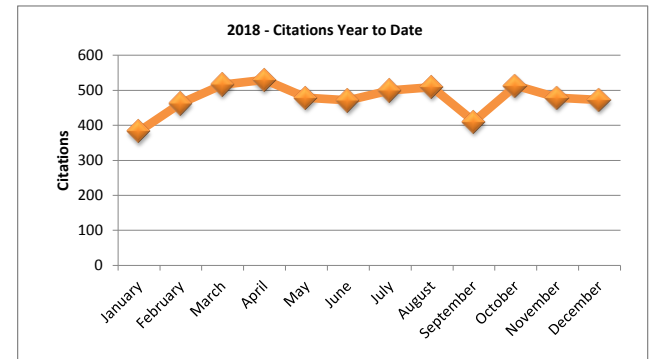
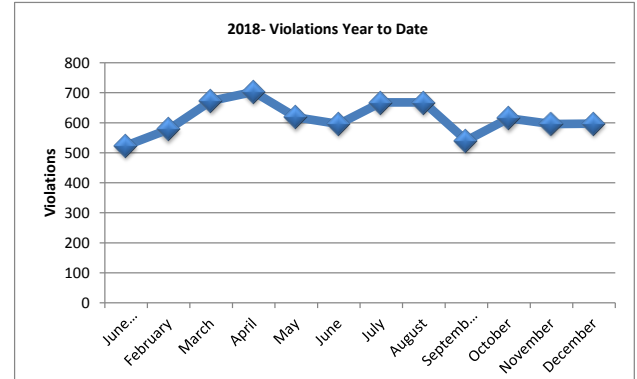

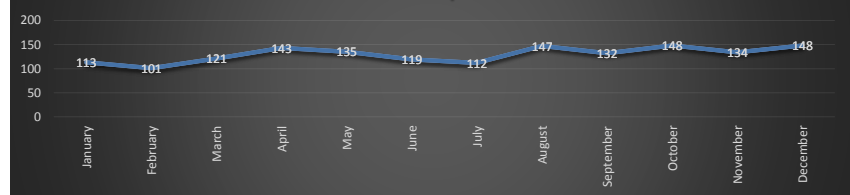

Day shift had the most crashes during the year of 2018. The highest crash time period was between 1501-1900 with 502 crashes. The highest occurrence of crashes took place on Friday. There were 4 fatal crashes and 268 crashes involving injury. There were 37 crashes involving alcohol/drugs. W. Andrew Johnson Hwy was the area with the highest number of crashes this year. The total number of crashes for the year 2018 decreased by 48, which is a 2.98% overall decrease from the previous year.
