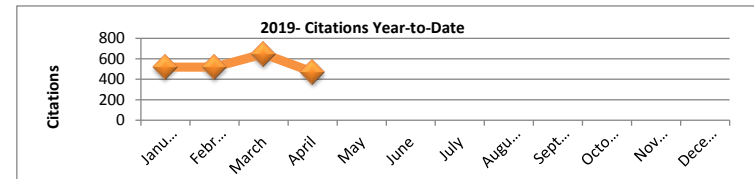
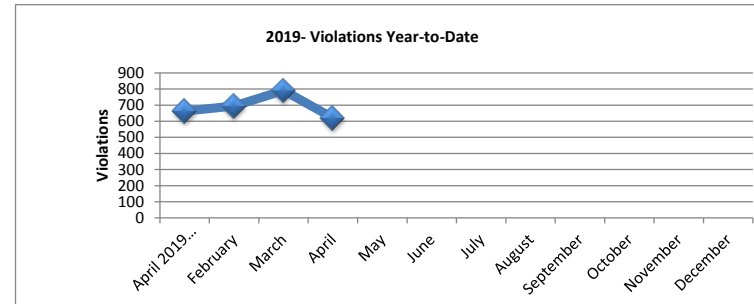

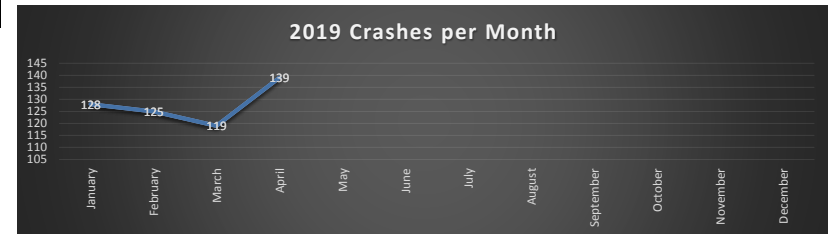

Day shift had the highest number of crashes during the month of April 2019. The highest crash time period was between 1501-1900 with 53 crashes. The highest occurrence of crashes took place on Monday. There were 20 hit and run accidents. There were 23 crashes involving injury and 5 crashes involving alcohol/drugs and 0 fatalities. East Morris Boulevard had the highest number of crashes this month. There were 139 total crashes this month. This is a 16.81% increase from the previous month.



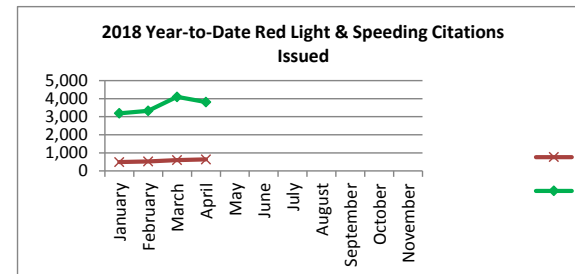
