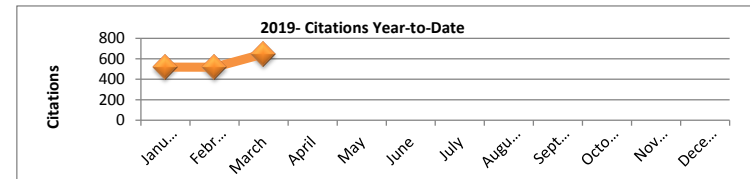

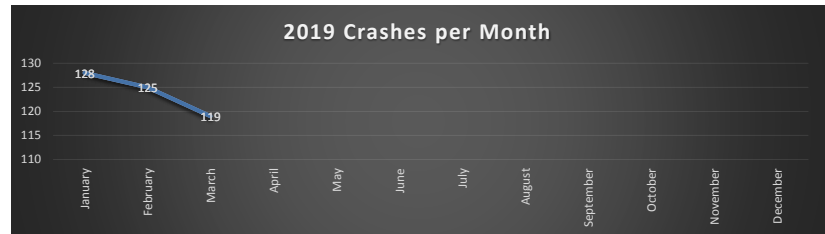

Traffic Crash Analysis

Day shift had the highest number of crashes during the month of March 2019. The highest crash time period was between 1501-1900 with 38 crashes. The highest occurrence of crashes took place on Friday. There were 21 hit and run accidents. There were 27 crashes involving injury and 6 crashes involving alcohol/drugs and 0 fatalities. West Andrew Johnson Highway had the highest number of crashes this month. There were 119 total crashes this month. This is a 4.80% decrease from the previous month.

2019 Crashes per Month



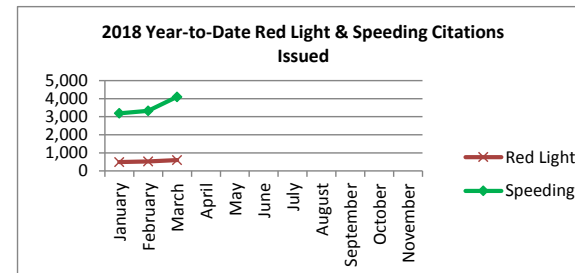

Total red light camera incidents reviewed increased by 11.35% from March to February. Fixed speed incidents reviewed increased by 28.02%. The overall total red light and speeding camera reviewed increased by 25.93%.
