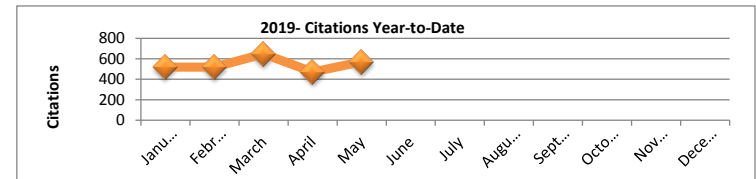
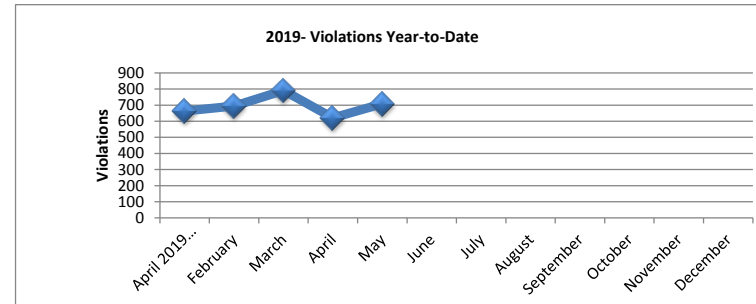

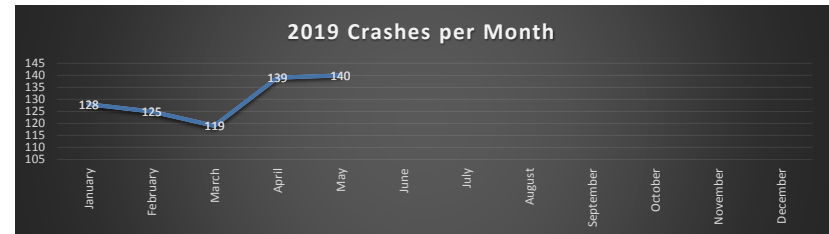

Day shift had the highest number of crashes during the month of May 2019. The highest crash time period was between 1501-1900 with 49 crashes. The highest occurrence of crashes took place on Thursday. There were 21 hit and run accidents. There were 16 crashes involving injury and 6 crashes involving alcohol/drugs and 0 fatalities. West Andrew Johnson Highway had the highest number of crashes this month. There were 140 total crashes this month. This is a .72% increase from the previous month.



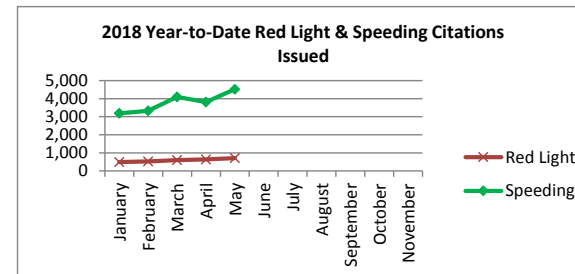

Total red light camera incidents reviewed increased by 13.05% from May to April. Fixed speed incidents reviewed increased by 11.97%. The overall total red light and speeding camera reviewed increased by 12.11%.
